

What did Jesus say about the world? John 16:33.

Jesus said, "In the world we shall have tribulation...but we should be of good cheer because He has overcome the world.

Here Jesus said that there are tribulations, trials, troubles, frustrations and wickedness in this world, but he did not end it there. He also said, Be of good cheer; I have overcome the world. Jesus did not overcome for himself; he overcame so that we can be overcomers too. Jesus started the statement with, "In me ye may have peace." It is only when we are in Him that true peace can come. What Jesus is saying is that the only place there is true peace and joy is in Him.

What invitation did Christ make to everyone with problems, frustrations, and trials in the world? - Matt. 11:28.



He said, "Come unto me all ye that labour..." and are heavy laden and I will give you rest.

Are you troubled? Jesus says, "Come." Are you sick? Jesus says, "Come." Is your family in crisis? Jesus says, "Come." Are you in financial crisis? Jesus says, "Come." Are you frustrated? Jesus says, "Come." Christ does not want you to carry your load all alone. He says, "Are you heavy-hearted?" Please come because He has rest for you.

Why did Jesus come? - John 10:10.		
Jesus did not come so that life can be more difficult for you. He came so that we can enjoy life, so that we can have fulfillment in this life. Christ wants you to have abundance. He wishes you well; He wants you fulfilled. That is why He came. A crippled life is not for you – a hard and tough life is not God's will and plan for you.		
Why was Christ manifested? 1John 3:8.		

Jesus came to destroy all the works of the devil in your life. What are the works of the devil? Everything that is making life uncomfortable for you, everything that is making you unhappy; and making you frustrated. These are the works of the devil. Sickness and diseases, poverty, barrenness, untimely death, joblessness, loneliness are also works of the devil. He came to destroy them. Would you allow Him to do that today?

What happens when a man comes to Christ? Proverb 4:18.

What are the three ministries of the devil? John 10:10.

The bible says, "The way of a sinner is hard." Things will continue to be hard until you change your nature and stop being in the devil's kingdom.

What did Christ do for us about Satan's dominion? - Col. 1: 13-14.



How can we overcome Satan and the evil in the world? - 1 John 5:4-5.	



To overcome, to be a candidate for victory, you must be born of God. To totally defeat the devil, you must be born of God. You must change your nature and your kingdom to become part of the kingdom of God.

What did Jesus say about changing your kingdom? John 3:3.	

Jesus is saying, unless you are born again and you receive a new nature, you cannot be in the kingdom of God.

Some time ago the newspaper told the story of a young girl who had raised a tiger as a pet. It was only a few days old when it was given to her. The girl was ever so kind to this pet and the two of them spent many hours together in play.

As the tiger grew larger and older, the girl was warned of the danger of having this wild animal for a pet. She had almost grown up with the tiger and was certain that the animal would never harm her. She claimed that all the wild traits of the particular tiger had been eliminated by its constant association with humans.

Then one day the girl cut her finger as she was playing with the animal. The tiger licked the blood from the wound. In a matter of a few seconds this kind, gentle playmate became a ravenous beast. Knocking its master to the ground, it viciously chewed and...

The girl was certain the nature of the tiger had been changed by its association with humans, but she discovered that it still had the nature and heart of a wild



animal. This story illustrates the nature of man. Man is born with a basically sinful nature. It is much easier for him to do that which is wrong and sinful than that which is good and right.

Education and training may develop some outward signs of good behaviour, but the evil nature inherited from Adam will remain.

The kind father and thoughtful husband can become a raging maniac when he has had a few drinks. Psychologists tell us that these outbreaks are due to hidden and repressed drives that are held in check by self control but show themselves when the self control is temporarily anesthetized.

Christ said that the religious leaders of His day were like "white-washed tombs, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness." *Matthew 23:27.*

In order to be right with God, we need forgiveness for our past sins. More than this, we need the evil nature, which produces these sins, changed.

You can do this by dropping to your knees just now and letting Him take control of your life. Perhaps you do not know how to come to Christ. Just repeat these simple words as an expression of your heart's sincere desire: "Dear Lord Jesus Christ, I am weak. I have sinned. Please forgive and



help me. Come into my heart and change me just now." Amen.
